Forest Management is key, along with fighting Climate Change. I support the GND's clean-tech jobs growth.

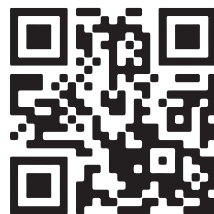
I will bring manufacturing back, invest in infrastructure, revolutionize healthcare with telemedicine, EMR, analytics and AI/ML.

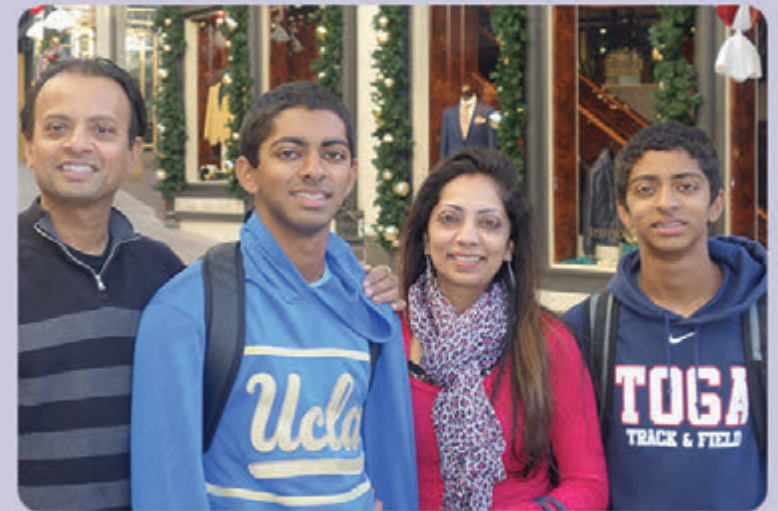
